SYNOPSIS

The Cost of Living is a surreal, comedy-noir about waking up to life: When Lily, a disconnected, neurotic, 'wellness'-freak, has a brush with death, she comes face-to-face with her greatest fear. But DEATH appears to Lily as a femme fatale and Lily finds herself unexpectedly giddy with desire...

CAST LILY LOVELESS - "LILY"



Lily Loveless is an actor and TV writer who made her name as an actor across TV, film and theatre. Lily has starred in shows such as THE STRANGER for Netflix, THE ROYALS and THE MUSKETEERS for the BBC. As a writer Lily has been fortunate enough to work with some of the country's best writers, she soon took an interest in the scriptwriting side of things, and was spurred on by Jack Thorne after reading her first script. Lily was accepted onto the prestigious 4Screenwriting course where she wrote her first official spec script. She has subsequently developed treatments for many prominent independent production houses including Tiger Aspect, Warp Films and Hillbilly.

GENESIS LYNEA - "DEATH"



Genesis is soon to be seen in the forthcoming 21 Laps / Netflix epic adaptation of Leigh Bardugo's bestselling fantasy novels, SHADOW & BONE in the role of Natacha.

Prior to this Genesis played the regular role of Dr. Archie Hudson in BBC's flagship medical drama CASUALTY.

An actress, singer and dancer, Genesis can be heard on the original cast recording of the international hit SIX, where she created and played the role of Ann Of Cleves.

In addition to this, Genesis played the role of Betty 5 in the original London cast of COLLECTIVE RAGE, created the

role of Nina in THE ASSSASINATION OF KATIE HOPKINS (Theatre Clwyd) and took the title role in London Old Vic's SYLVIA, a dramatic musical retelling of the story of the suffragettes, directed by Kate Prince.

ALICE TRUEMAN (EDITOR/WRITER/DIRECTOR)



Alice's first two short films screened at numerous prestigious festivals including BFI Flare, Encounters Film Festival and Raindance Film Festival, winning a British Film Institute competition for 'New Filmmaking Talent' and 'Best Foreign Film' at City of Angel's Women's Film Festival in LA. And her queer comedy sketch web-series 'Spoon the Prune' was broadcast on UK television stations and chosen for the Tribeca N.O.W. Digital Creators Market 2019.

Alice's recently completed short film, The Cost of Living, is funded by the BFI Network and she is a member of the BFI NETWORK x BAFTA Crew 2020/2021. Professionally, Alice has written and directed content for clients such as St Mungo's, The WildLife Trust and AXA and she also freelances as a film editor in branded content.

KATIE HODGKIN (PRODUCER)



Katie is currently in post-production on her second feature 'Martyrs Lane', written and directed by Ruth Platt, which is supported by the BFI. Her previous film, "Bruno" by writer / director by Karl Golden premiered at the Galway Film Fleadh in 2019 and went on to screen at Hamburg, Tallinn Black Nights and numerous other festivals.

Her short films 'The Cost Of Living, 'Cut' and 'Miss' have received backing from the BFI, Creative England, Erasmus, the Icelandic Film Centre and Shorts International.

In addition to producing, Katie has freelanced in development and production for the past 9 years, working on both indie hits ('Nina Forever', 'Snow in Paradise', 'The Banksy Job') and studio films ('Les Miserables', 'Maleficient').

Aside from feature films, Katie produces commercials and content for brands and charities.

Katie is an alumnus of the Berlinale Talents Campus and was recently selected to take part in Creative Europe's Co-Production lab.

ALEX HURLE (PRODUCER)



Alex is a producer working across film, television and commercials.

Alex produced the feature documentary THE BANKSY JOB, which premiered at the Tribeca Film Festival 2016 and was released internationally in 2017. Alex subsequently set up Vault Films to develop and produce features, documentaries and shorts from bold and exciting filmmakers.

Projects include the shorts THE COST OF LIVING, funded by the BFI and directed by Alice Trueman, and SOLITARY, directed by Ian Roderick Gray and commissioned by the NHS.

Feature projects Alex is developing include NOTHING SUCCEEDS LIKE SUCCESS, a feature documentary exploring the seminal recording studio, Trident which was selected for the prestigious Sheffield DocFest MeetMarket, and the drama, NOTHING IS TRUE, which explores the true story of William Burrough's run in with Scientology.

Alex also developed the feature horror MARTYR'S LANE written and directed by Ruth Platt, which featured at Film London's Micro Market, and Cinemart, in Rotterdam. The film is now in post-production, funded by the BFI.

Alex has also produced music videos and commercials for clients such as Sky Bet and ITV.

Alex is a graduate of the Sheffield DocFest Future Producer's School.
